# 1. WATERMARK

Look for the multi-tonal portrait combined with numbers, visible when held to the light.





# 3. SEE-THROUGH IMAGE

Look for the patterns on the front and reverse sides of the banknote complete a pattern of diamonds when held to the light.





### 2. SECURITY THREAD

visible as a broken line, and when viewed against the light it is a continuous line. Tilt the note to see a rapid movement up and down the thread's background and the diamond-shaped logo of the National Bank pulsate.





# 4. RAISED INK

Feel the raised ink on the portrait, signature and denomination.

The main concept design of the banknotes of the national currency the reflection of the historical and cultural heritage of Kyrgyzstan remained unchanged. Portraits of representatives of art and culture have been preserved on the front side and sights of the republic on the reverse side of the banknotes.

6. IRIDESCENT STRIPE The diamond-shaped logo of the National Bank and the denomination can be seen when the note is tilted.

Examine the banknote closely to reveal hidden microtext and images of flora and fauna hidden on the front and reverse of the banknote.
